1. Background

SOSEC Nepal is a non-governmental, non-profit organization established in 1997 with the mission of improving the socio-economic and cultural status of disadvantaged and marginalized communities in rural Nepal. Since its inception, the organization has worked to enhance education, health, livelihood opportunities, disaster risk reduction, and human rights, while strengthening social inclusion and institutional capacities at the grassroots level.

The organization was founded by youths of Dailekh who envisioned a prosperous and equitable society that actively includes Dalits, women, and diverse ethnic groups in development processes. Over the years, SOSEC Nepal has successfully implemented projects across Dailekh, Kalikot, Surkhet, and Achham districts in close coordination with local governments, line agencies, and donor partners.

Our vision is to build an equitable society through empowered institutions that play a vital role in integrated community development.

Our mission is to inspire breakthroughs in the way society treats children and to achieve immediate and lasting change in their lives.

2. Rational for the Assignment

Since 2024, SOSEC Nepal has been implementing the *Sahayatra III Project* in partnership with Save the Children in Chamunda Bindrasaini Municipality, Dailekh. A key focus of the project is Child-Friendly Local Governance (CFLG) a framework that ensures children's rights are safeguarded and prioritized in local governance, planning, and budgeting processes.

One of the foundational steps toward institutionalizing CFLG is the development of a Child Profile, a comprehensive document that captures the status, needs, and rights of children within the municipality. This profile serves as a crucial planning and decision-making tool, enabling evidence-based interventions and tracking progress towards child rights outcomes.



Objective of the Consultancy

The main objective of this consultancy is to prepare a detailed and accurate **Child Profile** for Chamunda Bindrasaini Municipality, in alignment with the CFLG Implementation Guideline 2078, and to develop a **Child Investment Plan** to guide local budgeting and program implementation.

Specific Objectives:

- 1. To review and validate raw data during survey. (data will collect by SOSEC Nepal)
- 2. To analyze and present child-related indicators (servival, protection, devlopment, participation, and institutional).
- 3. To prepare a comprehensive Child Profile report based on CFLG Guideline 2078.
- 4. To develop a realistic and actionable Child Investment Plan in consultation with local stakeholders.

3. Location and Official Travel

The consultancy will be carried out primarily in Dailekh District, with specific focus on Chamunda Bindrasaini Municipality. The consultant will be required to undertake field visits for developing child investment and stakeholder consultations.

4. Service the consultant will provide

The consultant (individual or firm) will be responsible for the following:

- Submit an Inception Report, including a detailed methodology, work plan, and updated technical and financial proposal.
- Review relevant national, provincial, and municipal policies, budget documents, and CFLG guidelines.
- Assess and validate the existing raw data collected by SOSEC Nepal or other stakeholders.
- Conduct consultations with municipal officials, service providers, and community representatives, including children where feasible.
- Analyze data and prepare a comprehensive Child Profile report using CFLG standards.
- Develop a Child Investment Plan that aligns with municipal planning and budgeting cycles.



• Present findings in a validation workshop with key stakeholders and incorporate feedback.

5. Timeline

The consultancy assignment will be completed by 31 October 2025.

6. Reporting and Coordination

The consultant will work in close coordination with the **Thematic Lead of Sahayatra III, SOSEC**Nepal, and provide regular updates as per the agreed timeline.
